

Tom Johnson checked in with a very favorable review of the DVD 'LIVE IN PARIS' featuring Diana Krall. Appearing with a full symphony orchestra (conducted by Alan Broadbent), Diana sings and plays the arrangements of Johnny Mandel and Claus Ogerman. Highlights, according to Tom, are the rehearsal footage of Ogerman conducting the tune "Love Letters," plus his actual appearance toward the end of the live concert. He conducts without a baton and it's interesting to see his total control over the orchestra. For Claus Ogerman fans, Tom also suggests the 4-CD set titled MAN BEHIND THE MUSIC (Boutique/Universal from Germany) with album notes by Gene Lees.
